We conduct **FREE** virtual or in-person training sessions for healthcare providers and other community members who work with older adults. These sessions cover how to recognize the signs of elder abuse, effective screening techniques to determine if an older adult is a victim, and guidance on referring them to the appropriate resources to ensure their safety and well-being.



We also provide **FREE** and confidential evidence-based trauma-focused mental health treatment, available via telehealth or in-person, to victims of crime, abuse, or neglect. We're actively collaborating with several police department victim advocate programs across South Carolina and maintaining close ties with the SC Attorney General's Office and the SC Victim Assistance Network.
